We are seeking a Clinical Geneticist to co-ordinate and jointly run cardiac genetics clinics in conjunction with cardiology consultant staff at both St George's Healthcare Trust and The Royal Brompton & Harefield NHS Trust. The postholder will develop links between the clinical genetics services and cardiovascular clinical services and be pivotal in service development. You will also be expected to establish a programme of externally funded research and you will be encouraged to develop your own area of interest in the field of cardiovascular genetics. You should have a previous record of publications in recognised journals and any experience of grant writing and existing grant income would be an advantage. The postholder will also be required to actively contribute to teaching programmes at both undergraduate and postgraduate level.

Candidates should have CCST and/or entry on to the Specialist register in Clinical Genetics. A higher degree (MD or PhD) and a clinical qualification recognised in the UK or EU is also essential.

Appointment will be made on the Clinical Academic scale £71,822 - £96,831 per annum depending on experience and seniority/threshold, plus London Allowance of £2,162 per annum.
